

## Total Solar Eclipse

#### What is a Total Solar Eclipse?




- A solar eclipse occurs when the moon casts its shadow on the Earth as it passes between the Earth and the Sun.
- A total solar eclipse occurs when the moon appears to totally obscure the Sun.

#### Path of Totality in Ohio

- The blue center line in the map shows the path of the 2024 total solar eclipse. The outer red lines represents the outer boundaries of the path of the totality viewing area.
- Areas in Ohio that are outside the path of totality will experience a partial eclipse.



#### Path of Centerline in Seneca County



#### Timing of the Eclipse

- ▶Partial Eclipse begins at 1:57 pm
- ►Totality begins at 3:11:24 pm
- ▶Totality ends at 3:15:16 pm
- ▶Partial Eclipse ends at 4:27 pm



























