All Junior Fair exhibitors will sell one animal with the auctioneer. If they have one or two animals the other animal will be listed at the add-on table in sale barn. We will have several people available to assist. Please be aware that you may place as many donations as you wish on any exhibitors second animal. All of the buyers that hoped to buy an animal may place a donation on any name. Add-ons can be as little or as much as you wish to give (minimum \$25). For buyers with the sum of their add-ons totaling \$200 or less, payment in full must be paid day of sale. Add-on forms will be available all week prior to the auction in the Livestock Sale Trailer located across from the Super Barn.

How Do You Participate?

If you are a new or returning buyer, you must register in the sale barn where auction is held prior to the sale. This should be done at least 30 minutes before the scheduled starting time of the sale. You will be given a number to be used during the sale, a sale order along with meal tickets. Or you may pick-up your number(s) during office hours the week of the fair. The sale is conducted as an auction with the animals being sold to the highest bidder. After a successful bid, you will be identified by number and your name will be announced.

* Every buyer must have a buyer number.

* All destinations will go to the base bidder. If you wish for your purchased animal to go to the processor, your home, or someplace else, you need to go to the sale booth immediately following the purchase of the animal to change the destination.

Methods of Purchase

PREMIUM BID: All livestock is sold by the head, NOT by the pound. When bidding is complete, the buyer has purchased the animal at the price called by the auctioneer. You have the option of purchasing for advertising or home consumption. The 4-H & FFA exhibitors will receive base market price plus your premium bid. Your bid is not exclusive – add-on's may be done by other bidders.

BUYERS GROUP: The Buyers group provides an opportunity for everyone to support the Jr. Fair. If you would like to support the Jr. Fair with a specific dollar amount (for example: \$25, \$50, \$100 etc.) or if you are unable to attend the sale, but would still like to help the 4-H & FFA as a member of the buyers group, you will have the option of buying livestock at the fair without the time commitment of being there. You will have the option of controlling your dollars either by individually or jointly buying an animal. We also have an anonymous group, which will still get the advertising but will not be connected to any one youth's project. This will relieve you from the problem that you missed an employee or customer's family project. Back to the Farm Feeder Sale - NEW TIME

This sale is an opportunity for anyone to purchase feeder calves to take home and raise. These animals are auctioned on Sunday, July 28th at 1 P.M. and are expected to be paid for and picked up by 5:30 p.m.

After the Sale

Methods of Payment – Cash/Check

Immediately following the sale, buyers are requested to pay for their purchases. This will take place at the sale office. The billing for the others will be sent the week following the sale. All bills must be paid by August 10, 2019, so that exhibitor's checks can be issued in a timely manner.

All sales are final. There are no warranties expressed or implied on any livestock sold at the sale. Every exhibitor has participated in a Quality Assurance Program. It is expected that all Seneca County Fair Book Rules and Regulations have been followed. The exhibitor will care for all animals until they are loaded on a truck.
